

# 1. Properties

## SITE COLLECTION URL

This property specifies the full URL to the Sharepoint Site Collection containing the library. Examples:

```
http://IntranetWSS:8080
```

```
.
```

The second example "." means the current Site Collection.

## RELATIVE SITE URL

This property specifies the relative URL to the Sharepoint Site containing the library. If the library is placed in the root site of the Site Collection the property should be left empty. Example:

```
Documents
```

"[default]" and "." may be used in a similar way as in the Site Collection property.

## LIST/LIB NAME

This property specifies the name of the list or document archive. Example:

```
Library1
```

"[default]" may be used in a similar way as in the Site Collection property.

## DOCUMENT LIBRARY

This checkbox should be checked if the specified list is a document library.

## **INITIAL FOLDER**

This property specifies the folder to display. The user will not be allowed to browse to a folder closer to the library's root than this folder. If the property is empty the root of the library is the initial folder.

## **DISPLAY FILE EXTENSION**

This property determines whether the file extension of files is displayed or not.

## **ORDER BY DATE**

This property determines whether the files and folders are ordered by name or by modification date.

## **Filename filter**

Only files with a name containing the string specified via this property is displayed. A value such as ".pdf" may be used to only display files of a certain type.

## **Cache time in seconds**

If all users have access to all files in a library then this property may be used to save valuable CPU cycles on the server. A value of 0 means that caching is disabled.
