1. Introduction

This release contains bug fixes and improvements.

This version is tested against SharePoint 2013 (Sep 2018 CU).

REQUIREMENTS

Wizdom version 3.7.3.0 supports Internet Explorer 9 or later versions, Microsoft Edge, Chrome and Safari.

2. New functionality

COURSE AND ACTIVITY

- **Send mail:** Another option is added to the "Send mail" menu: "Organizer". When this option is selected the email is sent to the organizer (contact person) for the course. This option is now the default option.
- **Filtering in course overview:** On the overview page, an extra input field is now displayed:

Show all types ▾ Show coming ▾ Show all departments ▾ 

This field may be used to filter the courses shown as a result of the other filters. Typing a text in the field and hitting <Enter> (or clicking the filter icon) causes the course list to be filtered by the given text. Courses are shown if the text is found in a course's Title, Additional Headline, Subject, Description or Organizer field.

WEBFORM

- **Hidden fields:** When a field is configured to be required but is hidden in the form (because it is dependant on another field) the form cannot be saved – the users cannot fill out the field, because it is hidden, and the field is required for the form to be saved.

It now works like this: If the required field is hidden the form is allowed to be saved, even though the field is not filled out.

NOTICEBOARD

- The mails sent from NoticeBoard are now based on a template. This way it is possible to include the alternative author or other fields in the mail. See the appendix in this note for details.

3. Bug fixes

NOTICEBOARD

- NoticeBoard fails to show profile pictures if these are located somewhere else than SharePoint.
- In some cases a NoticeBoard comment is shown, even if it is supposed to be deleted.
- Error when clicking "Unread comments". This bug is also fixed in Hotfix 1 for NoticeBoard 3.7.2.0.
- Comment icon is shown in the news list web part even if comments are not enabled for the news item. Clicking this icon makes it is possible to create a comment.
- Performance problems opening news items (only when using "SharePoint Social Integration"). This bug is also fixed in Hotfix 2 for NoticeBoard 3.7.2.0
- NoticeBoard configuration: If an SMTP server and a password is previously specified in the Notification settings and the settings are saved again, the password is cleared.
- Not possible to specify a port number for the SMTP server (#25 is assumed). You can now specify the port number like this: "smtp.domain.com:539".
- Showing news items occasionally fail when using SharePoint Social Integration. Other attempts to solve this problem in earlier versions obviously didn't succeed.

HANDBOOK

- Archived handbook pages are shown in A-Z webpart.

COURSE AND ACTIVITY

- "Number of free seats" does not take guests into account. This is now corrected, and the number of subscribed guests is shown under "Course info".
- "Number of tree seats" are miscalculated in some other cases as well.

OTHER ISSUES

- "User Profile Properties Information" webpart fails when attempting to save properties.
- Wizdom configuration: Saving revision settings times out

4. Appendix: NoticeBoard mail template

After this update has been installed, the list "NoticeBoardViewTemplates" now contains a template named "Email". This template is used when NoticeBoard sends emails. The default template looks like this:

```
<subject>__channelname__:  
__title__</subject><body>__content__<p>__author__</p></body>
```

which makes the emails look as before this update.

This template may now be modified. The contents of the <subject> field specifies the email subject, and the contents of the <body> field species the body of the email.

The following placeholders may be used in the template:

Note:

__alternativeauthor__ and __alternativeauthor email__ show the name and email address of the alternative author, if one is specified. If not, nothing is shown.

__alternativeauthor2__ and __alternativeauthor2 email__ show the name and email address of the alternative author, if one is specified. If not, the name and address of the regular author is shown.
